With the accuracy and efficiency of the Stripology Rulers, I reach for them first, no matter what quilting project I am working on. I look forward to sharing with you all things Stripology and the GEasy way - it will change the way you quilt.

We're in for a treat at our November guild meeting! Sallie Topfl will be sharing the beautiful art of Kawandi, a traditional Indian quilting technique. Created by the Siddi people of African descent in India, Kawandi quilts are stitched by hand using simple running stitches and built from the outside in. Get ready to be inspired by this unique and colorful way of turning fabric scraps into stunning works of art!

#### Class Overview:

Ready to sharpen your skills and get more from your Stripology® Rulers? In this **skill-building class**, we'll go beyond cutting basic strips and squares to explore precise techniques for creating essential quilting units. You'll learn how to confidently cut and construct:

- Accurate strips including ¼" strips
- Half-square triangles (HST)
- Quarter-Square Triangles (QST)
- Combination Units
- Flying Geese

Along the way, we'll cover 60° and 45° angle cuts, tips and tricks to improve accuracy, and build confidence in using Stripology Rulers.

#### What You'll Learn:

- Mastering ruler alignment for clean, consistent cuts
- Constructing basic units with precision
- Using your Stripology® Rulers to their full potential
- ▼ Techniques to save time and improve accuracy



Optional Project: The method for making Flying Geese will be taught using the GEasy Way. Those interested in creating the Back Home Table Topper (page 24 of Master Your Stripology Rulers Book) should bring the following fabric for their Flying Geese:

- Colored Fabric: 4 7 ½" squares and 3 6 ½" Squares
- Background Fabric: 4 9" squares and 3 8" Squares
  Feel free to cut all the table topper background fabric in advance. We will start working on the Flying Geese in class, but there won't be enough time to complete the entire project during class.



Fabric scraps will be provided for the skill-building units, including fabric for Flying Geese for those not participating in the Back Home Table Topper project.

#### What to Bring:

- Required: Master Your Stripology® Rulers book
- Required: Stripology® XL and/or Stripology® Squared Ruler at least one of these is required.
- Optional: Stripology® Squared Mini and/or Stripology® Quarters Mini
- Highly Recommended: GE Easy Ruler Stickers
- Required: Rotary cutter (45mm or 60mm with retractable blade) and cutting mat (18x24)
- Required: Sewing machine & thread
- Required: Basic sewing supplies (pins, scissors, seam ripper, etc.)
- · Optional: Small iron and pressing mat

The special items include one bundle of Robert Kaufman fat quarters (40 count) and a "Singer" toolbox.






# Projects Half Done Program

#### **Spirited Quilters Guild Holiday Quilt Exhibition**

November 22 – December 31

The Norcross Welcome Center and Museum regularly exhibits various artwork from local and traveling artists. We have been accepted to exhibit some of our fiber art in the form of "holiday" themed quilts. This exhibition will take place during the month of December to coincide with the community's various holiday events where the Welcome Center is a common meeting location.

The Norcross Welcome Center and Museum is located in the former rectory of the large early 19th century church currently housing the Lionheart Theatre. The welcome center has two large rooms used for displaying traveling art exhibitions including ours. These rooms are equipped with museum quality lighting and railings with wires to hold the art work. The welcome center is open and is staffed for security purposes Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. (except holidays). The wel-



come center is staffed for special events or by appointment during weekends or evenings. While we will include signage asking not to touch or handle quilts, there is no guarantee of this. The welcome center staff will be present but not actively monitoring this point.

The space is not huge but does have wall space for approximately 5 large quilts 8-12 small quilts/wall hangings. If anyone has a large free standing quilt display wall to lend to the occasion, we could add other larger pieces to the center of the 2 room exhibit space. As space will be limited, only one quilt per person. Date of submission and theme will be taken into consideration for final exhibit selection

#### Here are further "rules":

- SQG member submissions will have priority to participate.
- The quilt must be of a Christmas/holiday theme or colors
- The quilt/wall hanging must have a sleeve and poll/rod for hanging purposes
- We will create a sign for each quilt exhibited based on the information provided on the application (link below). This sign will be placed on the wall next to the quilt and not on the quilt itself.

If you do not have this or have any difficulties, please email Linda of your interest – list name of quilt, size, and attach a picture of the quilt (or pattern) you would like to submit.




